



The Regional Food System Infrastructure grant is intended to develop middle of the supply chain infrastructure to support small- and mid-size producers. The list below includes a broad but not exhaustive list of infrastructure intended to be mapped across the state. We will map the existing, planned, and needed infrastructure. This list is meant to provide some direction and understanding of the input the ROC & UC Davis RFSI mapping team is gathering.

- Milling (Grain, Oilseed, etc.)
- Sugar or Confectionery Product Manufacturing
- Fruit/Vegetable Preserving
- Bakery and Tortilla Manufacturing
- Snacks, Condiments, Spices, Seasonings, and Other Food Manufacturing (nut processing, etc.)
- Beverage and Ice Manufacturing
- Domestic Bulk Food Storage and Distribution Warehouse
- Domestic Processed Food Storage and Distribution Warehouse
- Road Transport (Trucking, etc.)
- Wholesaler, Aggregator, or Food Hub
- Cold Storage Warehouse
- Waste Reduction Facility
- Composting Facility
